2	Addition Number Bonds 1-9	Know the place value table and understand the headings. Use the place value table to identify digits.	
3	Addition Number bonds 1-20	Add numbers involving hundreds, tens and units. Add numbers involving thousands.	
4	Subtraction Number Bonds 1-9	Add numbers involving hundreds, tens, units, tenths and hundredths. Add numbers involving thousands and thousandths.	
5	Subtraction Number Bonds 1-20	Count money and coins to find a total	
6	Addition and Subtraction Number Bonds 1-9	Able to work out addition shopping problems. Calculate change from a shopping list.	
7	Addition and Subtraction Number Bonds 1-20	Able to work out shopping problems involving multiple purchases. Calculate change from a shopping list.	
8	Multiplication Tables Basic Facts 1-9	Able to work out shopping problems involving multiple purchases and addition. Calculate change from a shopping list.	
9	Multiplication Tables Basic Facts 1-20	Estimate the length of lines. Measure lines accurately to the nearest millimetre. Know the names of polygons.	
10	Division Basic Facts 1-9	Measuring angles to the nearest degree. Name angles according to size.	
11	Division Basic Facts 1-20	Multiply units by two digit numbers. Multiply units by three digit numbers.	
12	Multiplication and Division Basic Facts 1-9	Multiply numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. Multiply by multiples of 10, 100 and 1000	
13	Multiplication and Division Basic Facts 1-20	Divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000 Divide by multiples of 10, 100 and 1000	
14	Four Operations Basic Facts 1-9	Multiply two digit numbers by two digit numbers. Multiply three digit numbers by two digit numbers.	
15	Four Operations Basic Facts 1-20	Divide two digit numbers by units. Divide three digit numbers by units.	
16	Addition Table Drill	Begin to solve problems involving addition. Begin to solve problems involving subtraction.	
17	Subtraction Table Drill	Begin to solve problems involving multiplication. Begin to solve problems involving addition and subtraction.	
18	Multiplication Table Drill 1-5	Begin to solve problems involving division. Begin to solve problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.	
19	Multiplication Table Drill 1-12	Telling time from analogue clocks. Use time passages to solve problems.
